IMPORTANT CHANGES

Dog Licenses are no longer available at Police Headquarters, they can be obtained in the Administrative Office at Borough Hall. Please provide proof of Rabies Vaccine and spay/neuter certificate if applicable.

Mandated Recyclables for 2010

Computers, computer monitors and related electronic hardware, as well as analog or digital television are prohibited from being placed with other solid waste for disposal. They may be placed curbside on Tuesdays.

Plastic “Pourable” Containers have a neck smaller than the body. The are #1 & #2. These can be co-mingled with your cans.

Mixed Paper includes chipboard, letter-head, colored and white paper, junk mail and soft cover books, hardcover books with binding and cover removed, phone books, and shredded paper. Chipboard includes pizza boxes with the wax paper removed, boxes from cereal, cake mix, etc. Do not include food wrappers, paper cups, paper plates or any other products contaminated by food.

Button batteries & Rechargeable batteries are accepted at Borough Hall for recycling. All other batteries can be disposed of in your regular garbage.

• **BOROUGH CLEAN UP WEEK:**

• **BRUSH DROP OFF:** Brush will not be picked up during the months of December, January or February with the exception of Christmas Trees. You may drop brush off at the Public Works Building on January 16th, from 8:00am-11:00 and February 13th from 8:00am - 11:00.

• **COUNCIL MEETING DATES:** The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Neptune City meet on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of the month at 7:00 pm in Council Chambers at Borough Hall. The public is encouraged to attend.

• **DOG LICENSES:** All dogs over 6 months old must be licensed. Licenses are available in the **Administrative Office at Borough Hall**. The fees are \$13.00 with a spay/neuter certificate and \$16.00 without. These fees are due no later than January 31st. **There will be a late fee assessed of \$5.00 for renewals received after January 31, 2010.**

• **TAX PAYMENTS:** Tax and sewer payments are due February 1st, May 1st, August 1st and November 1st.

RECYCLING DATES 2010

Bottles, Cans and Pourable Plastic Beverage Containers #1 & #2 will be picked up together.

Newspaper, Cardboard and Mixed Paper will be collected together on alternating Wednesdays.

Bottles/Cans/Plastic Beverage Containers

January 6th, 20th; February 3rd, 17th; March 3rd, 17th, 31st; April 14th, 28th; May 12th, 26th; June 9th, 23rd; July 7th, 21st; August 4th, 18th; September 1st, 15th, 29th; October 13th, 27th; November 10th, 24th; December 8th, 22nd

Newspaper/ Cardboard/Mixed Paper

January 13th, 27th; February 10th, 24th; March 10th, 24th; April 7th, 21st; May 5th, 19th; June 2nd, 16th, 30th; July 14th, 28th; August 11th, 25th; September 8th, 22nd; October 6th, 20th; November 3rd, 17th, December 1st, 15th, 29th

ALUMINIUM, GLASS, PLASTIC, STEEL, TIN - All may be co-mingled in an open container. They must be rinsed clean and they must be food and beverage items only. No plate glass or dishware. Plastic should be from beverage containers only – **No soap, detergent or oil containers.** You may not exceed five 6 gallon containers or one thirty (30) gallon container.

NEWSPAPERS- Newspapers should be tied with string (no plastic bags) 2 bundles are permitted; not to exceed 50 lbs each.

CARDBOARD – Cardboard should be flattened to 2’ x 2’ sections and tied with string, 2 bundles are permitted; not to exceed 50 lbs each.

MIXED PAPER – Mixed paper should be placed in an open 30 gallon container or tied with string; 2 bundles are permitted, not to exceed 50 lbs each.

The Recycling Drop Off Center is located at: 41 TFH Way. The center is for Neptune City residents only. Tires are NOT accepted at the recycling center.

GARBAGE COLLECTION

The Borough of Neptune City will provide garbage collection to any residential dwelling or business in the Borough (except shopping centers and apartments with more than 15 units) that meet the following requirements.

- **Up to five (5) containers** (with lids) that do not exceed 50 pounds and/or up to 30 gallons in capacity, each, per pick up. All materials must be placed in front of your address and at the curb by 6:30 a.m.
- On your second pickup of the week (Thursday or Friday), you are allowed **up to three bulk items** – couch, mattress, chair, stereo, rug, etc. Rugs must be cut, rolled up and tied in bundles not exceeding 30 pounds each. All materials must be placed at curb line by 6:30 a.m.

Any dwelling or business that generates more garbage than what is stated above must provide for the entire collection and disposal at their own expense.

GARBAGE PICK UP SCHEDULE

ZONE 1

East side of Union Avenue to the Borough's eastern border. Collection days are Monday and Thursday. You may place up to three bulk items to the curb on Thursday.

ZONE 2

West side of Union Avenue to the Borough's western border. Collection days are Tuesday and Friday. You may place up to three bulk items to the curb on Friday.

Materials must be placed at the curb by 6:30 a.m. for collection. You should use containers with lids for your garbage that are thirty (30) gallons or less in size.

Trash will not be picked up on Christmas, Thanksgiving and New Years Day

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION:

Brush, cans & bottles, mixed paper, newspapers, asphalt, cardboard, chipboard, leaves, appliances, drums/tanks, tires

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS: Paints, oil, asbestos, gasoline, chemicals, pesticides, fertilizers, solvents, thinners, corrosives and material in liquid form.

HAZARDOUS WASTE: All Hazardous Waste is to be disposed of at Monmouth County Permanent Household Waste Facility located at 3161 Shafto Rd., Tinton Falls. You must call 732-922-2234 for an appointment.

DEBRIS COLLECTION – MONDAY

Provided by Public Works

BRUSH – *From March—November;* must be neatly stacked and cut into length not exceeding six (6') feet.

Christmas Trees may be placed to the curb for pickup on Mondays during the months of December, January and February.

Brush can be dropped off at the Public Works Building on January 16th, and February 13th from 8:00 am until 11:00 .

WOOD SCRAPS – Not to exceed a 3' x 3' x 3' pile. No major renovation or contractor debris will be collected.

PALLETS – Must be broken up, cannot be thrown out whole.

CONCRETE – Concrete must be broken into pieces that are no more than 50 lbs and a pile that is no more than 3' X 3' X 3'. No major renovation or contractor debris will be collected.

All materials must be separated into different piles and cannot be mixed together with anything else. All material must be at curbside by 6:30 a.m. for collection.

APPLIANCE/ SCRAPMETAL/ELECTRONIC COLLECTION - TUESDAY

ELECTRONICS– Computers, monitors, related electronic hardware, as well as analog or digital televisions without wooden cabinets

SCRAP METAL – Neatly stacked and cut into lengths not exceeding six (6) feet and/or 50 lbs.

APPLIANCES – Appliances include washers, dryers, refrigerators, air conditioners, hot water heaters, stoves, dishwashers, freezers, dehumidifiers and anything containing freon. You must obtain a sticker from the Borough Administrative Office at \$15.00 per unit. Pursuant to State Law, doors must be removed from appliances.

OIL TANKS – Tanks must be inspected by the Fire Code Official. They must be thoroughly cleaned and cut in half, or valve removed.

PROPANE & BBQ GRILL TANKS – Tanks must be empty and have valve stems removed. If tanks are not empty, contact Monmouth Hazardous Household Waste Facility at 732-922-2234.

CYLINDERS - Cylinders must be empty and have valve stem removed.

POLES – All poles must have concrete removed from them, including plastic swings and parts.

LAWN MOWERS- Oil and gasoline must be removed.

TIRES- Can be disposed of by calling Monmouth County Reclamation Center at 732 922-2234.

Any question on the cleaning or disposal of material from tanks, drums or cylinders, contact Monmouth County Health Department at 732-922-2234.

LEAVES

Leaves may be placed loose at the curb for collection from April 1st through May 31st and September 15 through December 15th. Do not bag your leaves, or put tree branches, sticks, grass or other debris in with the leaves.

Leaves will only be collected during these periods of the year.

Leaves in an open container or clear plastic bags will no longer be accepted.

GRASS CLIPPINGS

Grass Clippings have been banned from the County Landfill. The Borough of Neptune City will not pick up any grass clippings.

BOROUGH TRUCK RENTAL INFO

A \$250 deposit is required for the rental of the Borough truck, \$50 is the cost for the truck usage and the remaining \$200.00 is applied towards the dumping fee. Reimbursement or an additional charge will be assessed after the truck is dumped. The truck is available weeknights and weekends. You may stop in Borough Hall to make an appointment.

OTHER REMINDERS

- **Do not put food waste, oils or grease down your drains.**
- **Do not place debris within 10 feet of any catch basin or storm drain.**
- **Remember to move cars from the streets during snow storms so they can be plowed**
- **Regular batteries can be disposed of in your garbage, recycle button batteries & rechargeable batteries only at Borough Hall**
- **Dog Licenses are no longer available at Police Headquarters they are now available in the Administrative Office at Borough Hall**
