

## LEAVES

Leaves may be placed at the curb for collection as follows:

**April 1 - May 31**

**September 15 - December 15.**

Leaves will only be collected during these periods of the year. **Do not bag your leaves** or put sticks, tree branches, grass, or other debris in with leaves. Leaves in open containers or clear plastic bags will not be accepted. Please place leaves loose in curb line of the street leaving room for storm water runoff. Do not use lawnmower bags to collect leaves in case of accumulation of grass clippings.

**GRASS CLIPPINGS** Grass clippings have been banned from the County Landfill. The Borough of Neptune City will not collect them.

## BOROUGH TRUCK RENTAL INFO

The truck can be rented to haul away clean up or renovation materials that will not be picked up by any of the other regular collections.

**Required Rental Deposit: \$250**

(Truck usage: \$50 + Dumping Fee: \$200)

Reimbursement or an additional charge will be assessed after the truck is dumped. The truck is available week nights and weekends. For information, contact Borough Hall.

❗ Do not put food waste, oils, or grease down your drains.

❗ Do not place debris within 10 feet of any catch basin or storm drain.

❗ Remember to move cars from streets during snow storms so the street can be plowed.

### SNOW REMINDER

In the event of snow, all vehicles must be removed from Borough street so the plows may clear them. All residents are required to remove snow and ice from their sidewalks within 24 hours. In the case of ice which may be so frozen to make removal impracticable it should be thoroughly covered with sand or ashes. It is against Borough Ordinance to shovel or throw any snow or ice into the street.

### Mandated Recyclables for 2017

- **Electronic items prohibited** from being placed with other items for disposal:  
Computers, computer monitors, analog or digital televisions. Related electronic hardware. These items should be placed curbside on Tuesdays by 6:30 am or they may be brought to the Recycling Center 7am-2pm Monday-Friday.

**Mattress disposal:** As per Health Code rules all mattresses and box springs must be wrapped or encased in plastic. They will NOT be picked up if they are not.

- **Mixed Paper** includes:
  - **Chipboard:** cereal boxes, cake mix boxes, cracker and cookie boxes, etc.
  - **Paper:** Letterhead, colored and white paper, junk mail, shredded paper
  - **Books:** soft cover, hard cover with binding and covers removed and phonebooks

**Do not include:** food wrappers, paper cups, paper plates or any other products contaminated by food.

### Batteries:

- **Button batteries** (e.g., Lithium) and **rechargeable** batteries are accepted at Community Center and Borough for recycling.
- **All other batteries** can be disposed of in your regular garbage.

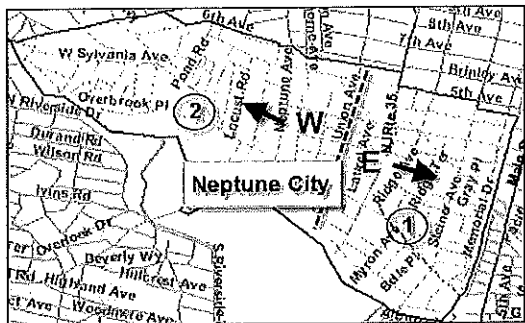
## GARBAGE COLLECTION

The Borough of Neptune City will provide garbage collection to any residential dwelling or business in the Borough (except shopping centers and apartments with more than 15 units) that meet the following requirements: Do not put items out more than 24 hours before your collection



- **Up to 5 containers** (with lids) that do not exceed 50 lbs. and/or up to 30 gallons in capacity each per pick up. All materials **must be placed curbside by 6:30 am.**
- **On your second pickup** of the week (Thursday or Friday), you are allowed **up to 3 bulk items**—couch, mattress, chair, stereo, rug, etc. Rugs must be cut, rolled up and tied in bundles not exceeding 30 lbs. each. All materials **must be placed curbside by 6:30 am, but no earlier than 24 hours prior to pick up**
- Any dwelling or business that generates more garbage than what is stated above must provide for the entire collection and disposal at their own expense.

Trash will not be picked up on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

All Recycling, paper, glass, plastic and cans can be mixed and put out together on your scheduled pick up day

**ALUMINUM, GLASS, PLASTIC, STEEL, TIN**—All of the following items may be comingled and must be rinsed clean. Food and beverage items only. **No plate glass or dish-ware.** Plastic should be #1 & #2. Cannot exceed five 6-gallon containers or one 30-gallon container.

**NEWSPAPER** - should be mixed in recycling buckets with other recyclable items.

**CARDBOARD** - Should be flattened to 2'x2' sections and should be mixed in recycling buckets with other recyclable items.

**MIXED PAPER** - Mixed Paper includes:

**Chipboard:** cereal boxes, cake mix boxes, cracker and cookie boxes, etc.

**Paper:** Letterhead, colored and white paper, junk mail, shredded paper

**Books:** soft cover, hard cover with binding and covers removed and phonebooks

Recycling bins can be purchased at the Borough Office.

## Items **NOT** Acceptable for Garbage Collection:

- Brush, cans and bottles, mixed paper, newspaper, asphalt, cardboard, chipboard (cereal boxes, etc.), leaves, appliances, drums, tanks, tires.
- **Hazardous Materials:** Paints, oils, asbestos, gasoline, chemicals, pesticides, fertilizers, solvents, thinners, corrosives and material in liquid form.



**Hazardous Waste:** All hazardous waste is to be disposed of at Monmouth County Permanent Household Waste Facility located at 3211 Shafto Rd., Tinton Falls. Call (732) 683-8686 for hours of operation.

## DEBRIS COLLECTION

Provided by Public Works—curbside by 6:30am on Monday

**No Contractor debris will be collected (including but not limited to: brush, wood, concrete, dirt, construction material, rugs)**

**BRUSH & YARD DEBRIS** - March - November. Must be neatly stacked and cut into lengths not exceeding 6 feet. Christmas Trees may be placed to the curb for pickup on Mondays during the months of December, January and February.

**WOOD SCRAPS** - Not to exceed a 3'x3'x3' pile. No major renovation debris will be collected.

**PALLETS** - Must be broken up, cannot be thrown out whole.

**CONCRETE** - Must be broken into pieces that are no more than 50 lbs. and a pile that is no more than 3'x3'x3'. No major renovation debris will be collected.

All materials must be separated into different piles and cannot be mixed together with anything else.

## APPLIANCE/SCRAP METAL/ELECTRONICS

Provided by Public Works— curbside by 6:30am on **Tuesday**

**No contractor debris will be collected.**

**ELECTRONICS** - Computers, monitors, related electronic hardware, as well as analog or digital televisions without wooden cabinets.

**SCRAP METAL** - Neatly stacked and cut into lengths not exceeding 6 feet and/or 50 lbs.



**APPLIANCES** - You must obtain a sticker from the Borough Administrative Office at \$15.00 per unit for the following items: Washers, dryers, refrigerators, air conditioners, hot water heaters, stoves, dishwashers, freezers, dehumidifiers, and anything containing Freon. Pursuant to State Law, doors must be removed from appliances.

**OIL TANKS** - Must be inspected by a Borough Official. They must be thoroughly cleaned and cut in half or valve removed.

**PROPANE & BBQ GRILL TANKS** - Must be empty and have valve stems removed. If tanks are not empty, contact Monmouth Hazardous Household Waste Facility at (732) 683-8686.

**CYLINDERS** - Must be empty and have valve stem removed.

**POLES** - Must have concrete removed from them, including plastic swings and parts.

**LAWN MOWERS & OTHER POWER EQUIPMENT**- Oil and gasoline must be removed.

**TIRES** - Can be disposed of by calling Monmouth County Reclamation Center at (732) 683-8686.
