BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Neptune City, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 95 of the Code of the Borough of Neptune City, entitled "*Parks and Playgrounds*" is hereby amended as under:

SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM
RESOLUTION OF PARTICIPATION**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATING WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY IN A SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL, JUSTICE, DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Neptune City wished to apply for funding for a project under the Safe and Secure Communities Program, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have reviewed the accompanying application and has approved said request, and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Borough of Neptune City for the purpose described in the application;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council that:

1. As a matter of public policy the Borough of Neptune City wishes to participate to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety.
2. The Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of the applicant.
3. The Division of Criminal Justice shall initiate allocations to each applicant as authorized.
