

**Council Room Borough of Neptune City
February 23, 2015**

The Regular Council Meeting of the Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor Robert Brown at 7:00 pm.

The Mayor asked everyone to join in on the Flag Salute.

Mayor Brown announced that the Notice Requirements of Chapter 231 P.L. 1975 have been satisfied by the publication of said notice in the Asbury Park Press, and Coaster and by filing a copy with the Municipal Clerk.

Moved and seconded (Cross/Zajack) to receive and file the Neptune City Police Department Report for January 2015. Carried.

In Mayor and Council Reports:

Mayor Brown announced Claire French, County Clerk for eighteen years will be retiring and wished her best of luck on her future endeavors and the classes she plans to take at Brookdale Community College.

Mayor Brown announced Christine Hanlon will be the new County Clerk.

Mayor Brown expressed the importance of the Snow Removal Ordinance for the safety of residents, children at the school and the Public Works Department and will be enforced if residents to not comply.

Mayor Brown expressed the Reverse 911 is an informational system used to educate and keep residents informed.

Mayor Brown reported the Senior Center Bus is now in service and will be making its first maiden voyage tomorrow to the store.

The Mayor thanked everyone involved in the process of getting the bus for the Senior Center.

The Mayor announced the Mayor's Round Table Meeting will be held tomorrow February 24th at 7:00pm at the Borough Hall with Monmouth County Economic Development Director Andy Fitzgerald and Freeholder Thomas Arnone.

The Mayor stated several business owners will be attending to discuss any concerns or interests they may have.

Councilwoman Renee expressed she is looking forward to the Mayor's Roundtable Meeting tomorrow and thanked the Mayor for having it.

Ms. Renee reported she had a Law and Ordinance Committee Meeting Tuesday, February 10th to discuss several budget topics in the coming year, including a part-time technical assistant to the Construction Official and request regular reports from the Construction and Zoning Officials.

Ms. Renee reported the Committee also discussed possible revisions Chapter 127, Vehicles Abandoned and chapter 28.1 Recreation Commissioner to be consistent with 28.2 and revisions to Chapter 113, Temporary No Parking.

Ms. Renee also reported revisions to chapter 55.4 disposal of brush and waste. Councilman More commended the Public Works Department and Gerrit De Vos for doing a great job during the snow storms.

Mr. More reported the Public Works Committee had their second meeting Monday, February 9th to discuss the final proposal for the budget.

Councilman Zajack reported he met with Community Center Director Tom Adcock to obtain a list of activities for the Community Center.

Mr. Zajack reported Mr. Adcock gave him a report mentioning 180 youth members and 145 senior members currently.

Mr. Zajack announced the Community Center will be having a Vascular Screening sponsored by Meridian Health Tuesday, March 3rd. The cost will be \$25.00.
