BOROUGH OF NEPTUNE CITY

ORDINANCE 2013-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEPTUNE CITY TO AMEND CHAPTER 100 ENTITLED "PRECIOUS METALS AND PREVIOUSLY OWNED JEWELRY" AND TO RENAME THE CHAPTER "SECOND HAND DEALERS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Neptune City as follows:

Section 1. The Code of the Borough of Neptune City is hereby amended and supplemented to change the title of Chapter 100 entitled "Precious Metals and Previously Owned Jewelry" to "Second Hand Dealers".

**CHAPTER 100
SECOND HAND DEALERS**

Section 2.

100-1. License Required

- A. No person shall engage in the business of purchasing or engage in the trade of business of buying and/or selling used goods such as precious stones, gold, silver, platinum or other precious metals, jewelry, gems, coins, tools, antiques, television sets, radios, record or stereo sets, electronic devices, musical instruments, sporting goods, automotive equipment, collectibles, cameras and camera equipment, video equipment or any other miscellaneous items without first having obtained a license from the Borough Clerk of the Borough of Neptune City.
- B. The business of buying or selling used goods as set forth in Subsection A shall not be deemed to include DVDs, CDs and video games.

100-4. Records.

All persons regulated by this Chapter shall maintain records for each sale which shall contain a description of the item purchased, a digital photograph, any identifying markings or numbers, and a copy of the signed receipt referred to in subsection 3 of this Chapter. A license holder pursuant to this Chapter shall deliver copies of the records required in this Chapter to the Neptune City Police Department on the first and fifteenth day of each month and upon demand of the Department. The items must be made available for viewing by the Neptune City Police Department upon request. All precious stones, gold, platinum or other precious metals, jewelry, gems, firearms and coins purchased by a license holder pursuant to this Chapter shall not be sold, transferred or otherwise disposed of for a period of seven (7) days following the purchase of such item and such item shall remain at the license holder's place of business during such seven (7) day period.

Section 3. Severability. Each section of this Chapter is an independent section, and the holding of any section, or part thereof, to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause, shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of other sections or parts thereof.

Section 4. Repealer. All Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective when passed and published as required by law.
