3. It is anticipated that the minutes on the subject matter of the Executive Session will be made public upon conclusion of the matter under discussion; and in any event, when appropriate pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-7 and 4-13.
4. The Governing Body will come back into Regular Session and may take further action.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately
