WHEREAS, one of the purposes of such an advisory committee would also be to honor those Borough Veterans killed in action, through recognition of those individuals with commemorative street sign installations; and

WHEREAS, membership in the advisory committee shall consist of a maximum of five members appointed annually by the Mayor, at least three of whom shall always be veterans of the armed forces and residents of Neptune City and one member shall be the Commander or their designee of Local VFW Post #;
