RESOLUTION 2023-33 BOROUGH OF NEPTUNE CITY COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY APPROVING PARTICIPATING WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY IN A SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW & PUBLIC SAFETY, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

WHEREAS, the Borough of Neptune City and the Neptune City Police Department wishes to apply for funding for a project under the Safe and Secure Communities Grant Program in the amount of \$32,400.00; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have reviewed the Subaward Number 23-1335, for the subaward period of 11/01/2022-10/31/2023; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety in the amount of \$32,400.00 and the Borough of Neptune City and the Neptune City Police Department in the amount of \$248,560.66 for the purpose described in the application; and
