Minutes: Motion to approve the minutes of March 26, 2019 was made by O'Heney. 2nd by Elmer. All were in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Adcock reports as of 4/15/19 the account balance was \$25,004.88

Public Portion: Chuck Mitchell, formerly of the NCBLL board, attended the meeting to give clarification of the future of Little League. Chuck advised the NCBLL no longer has their charter due to the decline in registration enrollment over the past several years. Chuck further stated, the enrollment decline was not because of a lack of effort on the part of league officials. He advised 2 seasons ago they had 7 sign-up dates and only 23 kids (all age groups) total signed up. They also advertised through the Wilson School and on the school's and Boro's signs, as well as in the Coaster newspaper. Neptune City kids would now have to sign up in Neptune Twp. if they wished to play Little League. Chuck advised he would be happy to assist the BOR in running baseball clinics over the summer. Elmer advised she would speak to parents to find out if there would be enough interest by the kids to hold such an event(s) and report back next meeting.
