"**Battle of the Badges**". The game time will be from 11:00am to 3:00pm. There will be Food Trucks and a D.J. This will be a Boro sponsored event.

**Summer Rec. w/ Bradley Beach:** Ended August 9<sup>th</sup>. Adcock stated it was a very successful program as in past years. No complaints.

**Concert in the Park:** Featured Mike Byrne and was attended by approximately 50 people. It was a very hot night which probably kept some folks away. Cost: \$2500 for Band and advertising. It was suggested to look for more local bands that would play throughout the summer at a lesser cost.

**Movie in the Park:** The Family Foundation had canceled their movie night in July and suggested to do a Movie Night with the BOR as a joint venture. They would handle the concessions and supervision. All members agreed this to be a good idea and were in favor. The Movie Night will take place on Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup> at Memorial Park, approximate start time of 7:30pm.

**Table Tennis Program:** Adcock advised 5 instructors to get background checks done. The BOR will pay for the fingerprinting from Indento-Go.

**Rec. Basketball:** Rec. basketball director Elmer will work on a flyer and sign-up application.

**Old Business:** Wardell still looking into on how materials can be purchased for the portable indoor bocce courts. He will report back at next meeting.

**New Business:** BOR received a \$200.00 cash donation from the Ricky Caliendo Mens Bocce League.
